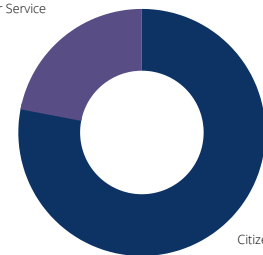

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- NPD RELEASES CRITICAL INCIDENT COMMUNITY BRIEFING WITH THE LATEST INFORMATION ON THE HOMICIDE AND OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING THAT OCCURRED IN THE 300 BLOCK OF E COMANCHE ST. ON JAN. 20.
- CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS RECEIVED INFORMATION ABOUT STOLEN PROPERTY BEING SOLD AT A LOCAL STORAGE UNIT SALE. AFTER OBTAINING A SEARCH WARRANT, APPROXIMATELY \$40,000 WORTH OF ANTIQUES, CONNECTED TO AT LEAST TWO BURGLARIES IN NORMAN, WERE RECOVERED BY INVESTIGATORS FROM THE STORAGE UNIT ON JAN. 20.
- NPD SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS SECTION, PATROL, AND THE PROBLEM RESOLUTION SECTION ARRESTED TWO JUVENILES FOLLOWING A MULTI-WEEK INVESTIGATION WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF OUR INTEL ANALYSTS. THE TWO SUSPECTS WERE CONNECTED TO VARIOUS BURGLARIES, STOLEN VEHICLES, AND THE RECENT BREAK-IN TO CAPTAIN JACK'S LIQUOR STORE. THEY WERE ARRESTED ON COMPLAINTS OF UNAUTHORIZED USE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE, FIRST DEGREE BURGLARY (2 COUNTS), SECOND DEGREE BURGLARY, LARCENY, AND FELONY ELUDING.
- SGT. KELLEE ROBERTSON WAS SELECTED AS THE NEW ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER MANAGER. SHE IS SLATED TO TRANSFER IN FEBRUARY.
- PATROL AND SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS DETECTIVES ARRESTED ONE IN CONNECTION TO A VEHICLE STOLEN IN THE 4500 BLOCK OF MIDWAY DRIVE ON JAN. 19, RECOVERING THE VEHICLE AND A STOLEN FIREARM.
- PATROL COMPLETED LIFE SAVING MEASURES BY ADMINISTERING NARCAN ON A MALE ADULT FOUND UNCONSCIOUS FOLLOWING A LIKELY OPIATE OVERDOSE ON JAN. 18.
- OFFICERS WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF K9 VADER LOCATED A MISSING 66-YEAR-OLD ALZHEIMER'S PATIENT AFTER HE WANDERED FROM HIS RESIDENCE INTO AN AREA WITH HEAVY TREES AND BRUSH ON JAN. 17.
