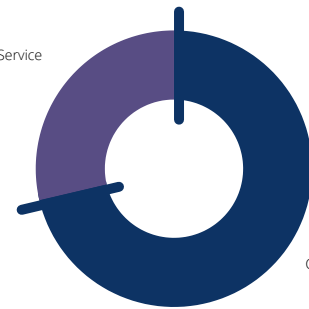

WEEK IN REVIEW

- NPd SAW MINIMAL SERVICE IMPACTS DURING THE RECENT WINTER WEATHER. THE DEPARTMENT WAS ON SLICK STREETS PROTOCOL FOR APPROXIMATELY 72 HOURS MEANING NO RESPONSE TO MINOR, NON-INJURY COLLISIONS.
- NPd WAS MADE AWARE OF POSSIBLE THREATS POSED ON A BATHROOM STALL AT NORMAN HIGH SCHOOL ON FEB. 17 AND IMMEDIATELY INITIATED AN INVESTIGATION. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING. NPd DID INCREASE ITS PRESENCE AT THE SCHOOL AND PUT INTO PLACE ADDITIONAL SAFETY MEASURES.
- NPd SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS SECTION WORKED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DISTRICT 21 TASK FORCE TO SEIZE APPROXIMATELY 13 POUNDS OF ILLEGAL COCAINE AS PART OF AN INTERSTATE DRUG TRAFFICKING CASE.
- NPd SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS SECTION ALSO ASSISTED THE OKLAHOMA BUREAU OF NARCOTICS (OBN) ON A WARRANT SERVICE IN NORMAN THAT WAS PART OF A STATEWIDE ILLEGAL MARIJUANA TRAFFICKING INVESTIGATION.
- NPd WAS CALLED TO A RESIDENCE IN THE 1600 BLOCK OF W. ROBINSON ON FEB. 21 ON A REPORT OF A MAN WITH WEAPONS THREATENING TO KILL A FEMALE. DISPATCH COULD HEAR THE THREATS BEING MADE. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED THE VICTIM WHO HAD GOTTEN OUT OF THE APARTMENT AND THE SUSPECT WHO WAS ATTEMPTING TO LEAVE THE SCENE IN A VEHICLE. OFFICERS TOOK THE MALE INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT. THE FIREARM INVOLVED WAS ALSO SEIZED.
- NPd IS CURRENTLY HIRING POSITIONS IN ANIMAL WELFARE, RECORDS, PARKING, AND POLICE OFFICERS - LATERAL ENTRY.
