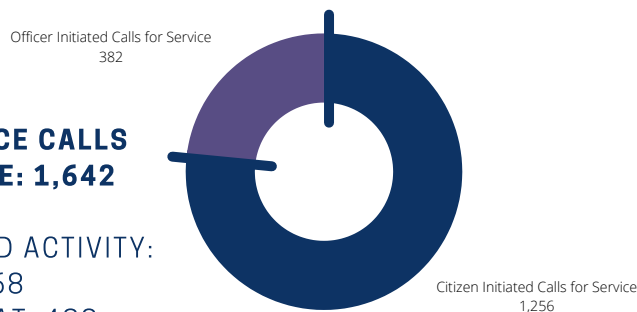

WEEK IN REVIEW

- NPD IS INVESTIGATING A PURSUIT AND OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING THAT OCCURRED ON APRIL 7 JUST BEFORE 9PM IN THE AREA OF STATE HIGHWAY 9 AND 60TH AVE SE. A FULL RELEASE DETAILING ALL AVAILABLE INFORMATION ON THE INCIDENT IS AVAILABLE AT NORMANPD.NORMANOK.GOV.
- NPD IS INVESTIGATING A FATAL SHOOTING THAT OCCURRED AT 11:26AM ON APRIL 9 IN THE 400 BLOCK OF W. LINDSEY STREET. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES AN INDIVIDUAL APPROACHED A VEHICLE AND A DISTURBANCE OCCURRED. DURING THE DISTURBANCE, THE DRIVER PRODUCED A FIREARM AND SHOT THE INDIVIDUAL WHO DIED AT THE SCENE. ALL INVOLVED PARTIES ARE COOPERATING WITH THE ONGOING INVESTIGATION.
- OFFICERS ARRESTED ONE ON APRIL 6 FOR SHOPLIFTING. THE INDIVIDUAL HAD A LARGE AMOUNT OF STOLEN PROPERTY FROM MULTIPLE STORE AND WAS DETERMINED TO BE CONNECTED TO OTHER INCIDENTS ACROSS OKLAHOMA. SHE WAS BOOKED INTO JAIL ON GRAND LARCENY CHARGES.
- OFFICERS ARRESTED ONE INDIVIDUAL IN CONNECTION TO A DISTURBANCE IN THE AREA OF DAWS AND WEBSTER ON APRIL 6. A 62-YEAR-OLD MALE WAS SHOT WITH AN AIR SOFT GUN BY HIS 19-YEAR-OLD SON WHILE DRIVING. THE SON ALSO MADE THREATS STAB HIM WITH A KNIFE. OFFICERS LOCATED THE VEHICLE AND ARRESTED THE 19-YEAR-OLD MALE FOR ASSAULT AND OUTSTANDING WARRANTS.
