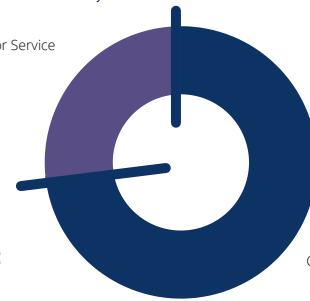

- MEMBERS OF THE HAZARDOUS DEVICES UNIT ASSISTED MCCLAIN COUNTY DEPUTIES WITH SERVING A WARRANT WHERE EXPLOSIVES WERE FOUND.
- OFFICERS ASSISTED OU PD WITH A SUBJECT THREATENING TO JUMP OFF A ROOF. THE SUBJECT VOLUNTARILY CAME DOWN FROM THE ROOF, BUT FLED AND CLIMBED A TRAIN CAR. OFFICERS USED A DRONE TO RE-LOCATE THE SUBJECT AND THEN ESTABLISHED RAPPORT TO DE-ESCALATE AND ULTIMATELY PLACE THE SUBJECT IN PROTECTIVE CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A CAR VS. PEDESTRIAN COLLISION NEAR IRVING MIDDLE SCHOOL. THE DRIVER LOOKED AWAY FROM THE ROAD BRIEFLY BEFORE STRIKING THE STUDENT. THE STUDENT RECEIVED NON-LIFE THREATENING INJURIES.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN ATV ACCIDENT ON THE CANADIAN RIVER. THEY WORKED WITH CITIZENS IN TRUCKS AND ATVS TO ACCESS THE VICTIM WHO WAS TOO SEVERELY INJURED TO MOVE. OFFICERS WORKED IN DARKNESS, FORDED HIGH-WATER, AND TRAVELED MILES FROM THE NEAREST ROAD TO PROVIDE SPECIFIC COORDINATES FOR OTHER RESPONDERS. THEY ASSISTED WITH LIFE-SAVING EFFORTS AND CLEARED A LANDING AREA WHILE USING A VARIETY OF SIGNALING DEVICES TO ASSIST WITH EXTRACTION BY AN AIR AMBULANCE. THE VICTIM WAS SUCCESSFULLY TRANSPORTED IN CRITICAL CONDITION.
