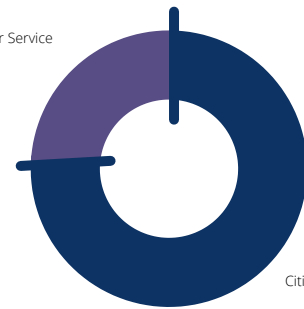

- NPd PARTICIPATED IN SAFETY TOWN, JAZZ IN JUNE, JUNETEENTH FESTIVITIES, AND SALVATION ARMY COMMUNITY COOKOUT
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY IN S.E. NORMAN AND NOTICED A VEHICLE MATCHING ONE INVOLVED IN EARLIER CATALYTIC CONVERTER THEFTS. THE SUSPECTS FLED BUT WERE QUICKLY ARRESTED ON MULTIPLE FELONY CHARGES
- THE HAZARDOUS DEVICES UNIT RECEIVED FBI RE-CERTIFICATION
- PATROL RESPONDED TO A RECKLESS DRIVER ON HWY 9. BEFORE ARRIVING, THE RECKLESS VEHICLE LEFT THE ROADWAY, WENT AIRBORNE, HIT A BRIDGE, AND DROPPED 20-30'. OFFICERS LOCATED THE UNRESPONSIVE DRIVER AND RENDERED AID. THE DRIVER OF ANOTHER INVOLVED VEHICLE ALSO RECEIVED CARE. BOTH WERE TRANSPORTED FOR FURTHER TREATMENT
