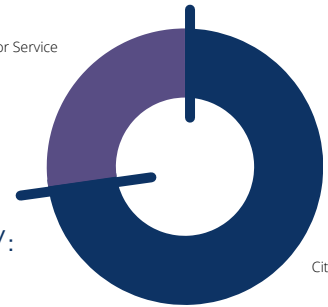

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- POLICE RECEIVED A CALL ABOUT A SHOOTING IN THE 1200 BLOCK OF 12TH AVENUE SE. THE CALLER REPORTED THAT HE HAD SHOT A BURGLARY SUSPECT INSIDE A BUSINESS. WHEN OFFICERS ARRIVED, THEY FOUND A DECEASED MALE INSIDE THE BUILDING. DETECTIVES ARE INVESTIGATING THE INCIDENT.
- THE NORMAN COMMUNICATIONS CENTER RECEIVED A CALL ABOUT A BURGLARY IN THE 200 BLOCK OF CHALMETTE DRIVE. THE CALLER ADVISED THAT FOUR PEOPLE BROKE INTO A RESIDENCE AND TOOK MONEY. THE GROUP OF PEOPLE WERE LAST SEEN LEAVING THE RESIDENCE. THE INCIDENT IS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- OFFICERS WERE NOTIFIED OF AN ATTEMPTED ROBBERY AT A PHARMACY. A MALE ENTERED THE BUSINESS, BRANDISHED KNIFE AND DEMANDED A MEDICATION. EMPLOYEES TOLD THE SUSPECT THAT THE PRESCRIPTION WAS NOT IN STOCK. THE SUSPECT LEFT THE STORE. DETECTIVES ARE INVESTIGATING THE INCIDENT.
- OFFICIALS BROKE GROUND ON THE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS AND OPERATIONS CENTER (ECOC) AT 2801 E. ROBINSON STREET. THE NEW, MODERN FACILITY WILL PROVIDE MUCH NEEDED SPACE AND UNIFICATION OF NECESSARY RESOURCES CRITICAL FOR SAFE AND EFFECTIVE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS. THE OPERATIONS CENTER IS EXPECTED TO BE OPEN SUMMER OF 2024.
