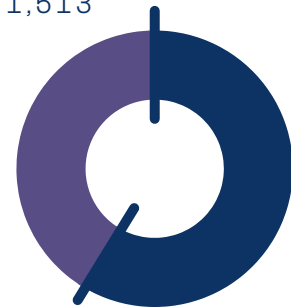

WEEK IN REVIEW

- CIRT INVESTIGATED A FATALITY COLLISION IN THE 11800 BLK OF HWY 9. PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT A WESTBOUND VEHICLE CROSSED LEFT OF CENTER AND COLLIDED WITH AN EASTBOUND VEHICLE. TWO OTHER VEHICLES WERE INVOLVED. THE DRIVER OF THE WESTBOUND VEHICLE WAS PRONOUNCED DECEASED AT THE SCENE. THE DRIVER OF THE EASTBOUND VEHICLE WAS TRANSPORTED WITH A POTENTIALLY BROKEN LEG. THERE WERE NO OTHER INJURIES REPORTED.
- A MALE SUBJECT CAME INTO THE LOBBY AND CONFESSED TO KILLING A PERSON WHO HAD BEEN DISCOVERED AT LAKE THUNDERBIRD. OSBI WAS INVESTIGATING AND RESPONDED. PRELIMINARY INFORMATION INDICATES THE VICTIM WAS MURDERED AT AN APARTMENT IN SOUTHEAST NORMAN.
