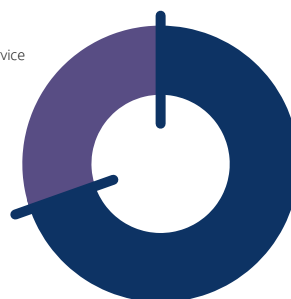

WEEK IN REVIEW

- SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS SECTION SERVED A SEARCH WARRANT LAST WEEK THAT RESULTED IN THE SEIZURE OF SEVERAL GUNS, HUNDREDS OF ROUNDS OF AMMO, AND LARGE QUANTITIES OF ILLEGAL NARCOTICS. THE OCCUPANT OF THE RESIDENCE WAS ARRESTED ON NUMEROUS FELONY CHARGES.
- IN THE EARLY MORNING HOURS OF MARCH 31, DISPATCH WAS NOTIFIED OF A COLLISION WITH INJURY AT 12TH SE AND LINDSEY ST. INVOLVING A MOTORCYCLE AND A CAR. PRELIMINARY INFORMATION SUGGESTS THE CAR WAS EAST ON LINDSEY ST. WITH A GREEN TRAFFIC SIGNAL TURNING LEFT TO PROCEED NORTH ON 12TH. THE MOTORCYCLE WAS SOUTH ON 12TH WITH A RED TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND FAILED TO STOP. THE MOTORCYCLE STRUCK THE FRONT OF THE CAR, AND THE DRIVER WAS NOT WEARING A HELMET. CIRT RESPONDED AND THEIR INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- DURING THE MORNING OF MARCH 30, MOORE PD NOTIFIED OUR AGENCY THAT THEIR UNITS WERE PURSUING A STOLEN VEHICLE INTO OUR JURISDICTION. MOORE PD LOST CONTACT WITH THE VEHICLE. ALMOST IMMEDIATELY, CITIZENS REPORTED A VEHICLE MATCHING THE DESCRIPTION INVOLVED IN AN INJURY COLLISION AT THE INTERSECTION OF 12TH NE AND ROBINSON ST. TWO SUSPECTS FLED ON FOOT AND STOLE A VEHICLE FROM GRIFFIN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL. OFFICERS SAW THE VEHICLE WHICH REFUSED TO STOP. THE VEHICLE THEN STRUCK A NORMAN PD UNIT BEFORE BEING STOPPED. TWO MALE SUSPECTS, AGED 14 AND 17, WERE TAKEN INTO CUSTODY.
