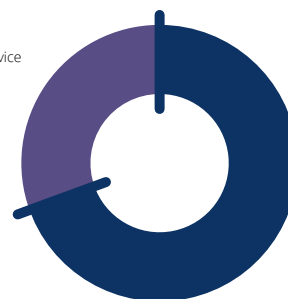

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A MISSING PERSON IN THE 12400 BLOCK OF E. CEDAR LANE ON AUGUST 14. THE ELDERLY RESIDENT SUFFERED FROM DEMENTIA, AND HAD NOT RETURNED FROM AN EARLIER MEDICAL APPOINTMENT. AN OFFICER COMPLETED AN ENDANGERED MISSING PERSON REPORT RESULTING IN A SILVER ALERT BEING ISSUED. THE SUBJECT WAS LOCATED SAFE BY LAW ENFORCEMENT IN CHILDRESS, TX WITHIN AN HOUR OF THE ALERT BEING ISSUED.
- SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS, ALONG WITH INDIVIDUALS FROM EVERY BUREAU OF THE DEPARTMENT, ASSISTED WITH WELCOMING STUDENTS BACK TO SCHOOL AT ALL NPS SITES ON AUGUST 17. IT WAS EXCITING TO SEE AND RECONNECT WITH STUDENTS AND STAFF WHILE GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE SRO PROGRAM CONTINUES WITH THE ADDITION OF OUR NEW CLEVELAND COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE PARTNERS.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 44 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 17 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 78 ANIMALS. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 221 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 53 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
