WEEK IN REVIEW

- PATROL RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING IN THE 100 BLK OF W DALE AT 3:14AM ON 9/24. THE REPORTING PARTY CLAIMED THAT HE AND HIS FRIENDS WERE IN A VEHICLE WHEN ANOTHER VEHICLE PULLED UP AND FIRED MULTIPLE SHOTS AT THEM. OFFICERS CHECKED THE AREA AND WERE UNABLE TO LOCATE ANYONE WITH INJURIES OR EVIDENCE OF A SHOOTING. THE JUVENILE VICTIMS BECAME UNCOOPERATIVE WITH OFFICERS AFTER THE INITIAL REPORTING, FOLLOW-UP WITH PARENTS/GUARDIANS WAS COMPLETED.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A VEHICLE IN A PRIVATE LAKE NEAR TECUMSEH RD AND DEREK LN ON 9/24. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION REVEALED THAT THE DRIVER HAD A MEDICAL EPISODE THAT RESULTED IN THEM LEAVING THE ROADWAY, CRASHING INTO THE LAKE. A PASSERBY SAW THE INITIAL INCIDENT AND ATTEMPTED TO RESCUE THE DRIVER FROM THE SINKING VEHICLE. OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS ENTERED THE WATER, CHECKED THE VEHICLE, AND ENSURED THERE WERE NO OTHER VICTIMS. THE DRIVER WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL.
- · COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED A 911 CALL REGARDING A FOUND BODY IN THE RESTROOM OF A BUSINESS IN THE 3200 BLK OF W ROBINSON ST ON 9/24. OFFICERS QUICKLY RESPONDED, PERFORMED CPR, AND ULTIMATELY REVIVED THE SUBJECT. THE SUBJECT WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN LOCAL HOSPITAL AND IS EXPECTED TO MAKE A FULL RECOVERY.
- THE INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION IS ACTIVELY INVESTIGATING A FRAUD CASE THAT HAS EXPANDED ACROSS CENTRAL OKLAHOMA. THE CASE BEGAN WHEN SUSPECTS ATTEMPTED TO FRAUDULENTLY PURCHASE A VEHICLE FROM A NORMAN CAR DEALERSHIP WITH STOLEN IDENTIFYING INFORMATION. SINCE THAT TIME, INVESTIGATORS HAVE UNCOVERED MULTIPLE ATTEMPTS AT THE SAME SCHEME AND DOZENS OF VICTIMS IN MULTIPLE JURISDICTIONS. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- · ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 44 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 9 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, A TOTAL OF 62 ANIMALS WERE TAKEN INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 232 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 68 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS
