WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE IN THE 1500 BLOCK OF ELK CIRCLE ON 5/3. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS ATTEMPTED TO PLACE THE SUSPECT UNDER ARREST FOR AGGRAVATED DOMESTIC ABUSE WHEN HE BARRICADED HIMSELF WITHIN THE RESIDENCE. THE SUSPECT WAS LATER TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND BOOKED INTO CCDC ON COMPLAINTS OF AGGRAVATED DOMESTIC ABUSE, RESISTING ARREST, AND OBSTRUCTION.
- NPD CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS HELD A COMMUNITY MEETING ON SEXTORTION. THE INFORMATION SESSION -- TARGETED AT PARENTS AND YOUNG ADULTS -- WILL EXPLORE SEXTORTION, THE GROWING TREND OF BLACKMAIL USED FOR THE GAIN OF SEXUAL MATERIAL OR MONEY THROUGH ONLINE MANIPULATION AND THREATS. THIS EVENT WILL HELP EQUIP PARENTS WITH INFORMATION ON CURRENT CRIME TRENDS -- AS WELL AS TIPS, RESOURCES, AND INSIGHTS ON HOW TO TALK TO YOUTH ABOUT INTERNET SAFETY.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 21 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 1 ANIMAL TRANSFERRED TO A RESCUE, AND 10 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 79 ANIMALS INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 173 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 62 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
