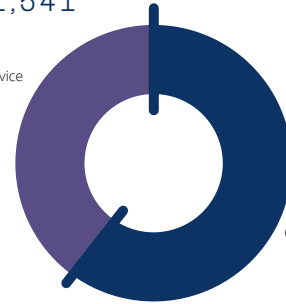

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SUSPICIOUS PERSON IN THE 400 BLOCK OF ALPINE DRIVE ON 5/10. THE CALLER REPORTED TWO INDIVIDUALS ATTEMPTING TO BREAK INTO THEIR CAR. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED THE TWO SUSPECTS. ONE SUSPECT WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AFTER A FOOT PURSUIT. THE OTHER WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AFTER BEING LOCATED BY A DRONE. BOTH WERE BOOKED INTO CCDC ON ASSOCIATED CHARGES.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A POSSIBLE DRIVE-BY SHOOTING IN THE 900 BLOCK OF 24TH AVE SW ON 5/11. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES A DISPUTE BETWEEN FAMILY MEMBERS HAD OCCURRED. DURING THE COURSE OF THE DISTURBANCE, ONE INDIVIDUAL FIRED SEVERAL SHOTS BEFORE LEAVING THE AREA. EVIDENCE OF SHOTS FIRED WAS LOCATED AT THE SCENE. NO INJURIES OR PROPERTY DAMAGE WERE REPORTED. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 22 ANIMALS ADOPTED, ONE ANIMAL TRANSFERRED TO A RESCUE, AND 13 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, 58 ANIMALS WERE TAKEN INTO THE SHELTER. THERE ARE CURRENTLY 194 ANIMALS IN THE CARE OF NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE WITH 66 OF THOSE CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
