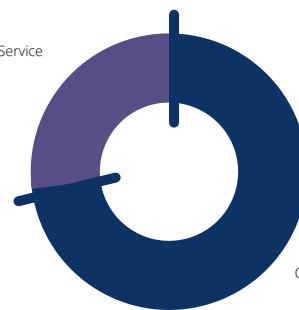

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS -- WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE US POSTAL INSPECTORS --INTERCEPTED APPROXIMATELY 5 POUNDS OF METHAMPHETAMINE SCHEDULED TO BE DELIVERED TO A NORMAN ADDRESS ON FEBRUARY 28.
- AN NPD OFFICER WORKING TRAFFIC IN THE AREA OF MADISON ELEMENTARY -- 500 JAMES DRIVE -- OBSERVED A VEHICLE TRAVELING APPROXIMATELY 100 MPH. THE OFFICER ATTEMPTED TO STOP THE VEHICLE BUT THE DRIVER CONTINUED EVENTUALLY ABANDONING THE VEHICLE IN A NEARBY APARTMENT COMPLEX. HE WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY ON CONSTITUTION ST. AND BOOKED INTO THE CLEVELAND COUNTY DETENTION CENTER ON COMPLAINTS OF RECKLESS DRIVING, ELUDING, AND DRIVING WITHOUT A DRIVER'S LICENSE.
- NPD ARRESTS ON IN CONNECTION TO A REPORT OF A ROBBERY AT CONVENIENCE STORE LOCATED AT 8320 E. FRANKLIN RD AT APPROXIMATELY 8:30 P.M. ON MARCH 3. THE VICTIM, THE STORE CLERK, TOLD POLICE THAT WE SHE EXITED THE STORE FOR A BREAK, WHEN THE SUSPECT APPEARED WITH A METAL PIPE. HE FORCED HER TO REENTER THE STORE AND PLACE MONEY FROM THE REGISTER AND OTHER ITEMS INTO A TRASH CAN BEFORE LEAVING. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED.
