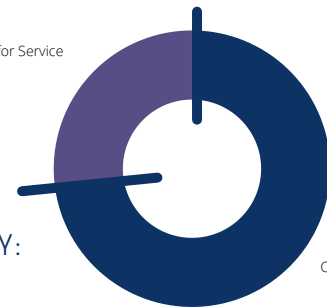

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS INVESTIGATED TWO SEPARATE DRUG OVERDOSE INCIDENTS. ONE WAS NOT INITIALLY REPORTED BY A WITNESS, AND ANOTHER WAS REPORTED APPROPRIATELY. INVESTIGATIONS BY DETECTIVES CONTINUE.
- OFFICERS STOPPED A VEHICLE LEAVING A LOCAL CLUB AFTER OBSERVING A TRAFFIC VIOLATION. THE OFFICER ARRESTED THE DRIVER FOR BEING EXTREMELY IMPAIRED. DURING A SEARCH, A DUFFLE BAG WITH SIGNIFICANT AMOUNTS OF FENTANYL, CASH, AND THREE BAGS OF MARIJUANA WERE FOUND INSIDE THE CAR.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN UNSUPERVISED 3 YEAR OLD CHILD NEAR AN INTERSECTION. SEVERAL OTHER CALLS REGARDING THE CHILD HAVE BEEN RECEIVED IN RECENT WEEKS. THE CHILD ALSO HAD SUSPICIOUS INJURIES. THE MOTHER WAS FOUND AT HER RESIDENCE SEVERAL BLOCKS AWAY AND SUBSEQUENTLY ARRESTED. THE CHILD WAS PLACED IN PROTECTIVE CUSTODY.
- AN OFFICER SAW TWO VEHICLES DRIVING RECKLESSLY IN A VACANT SCHOOL PARKING LOT. THE OFFICER INITIATED CONTACT, BUT BOTH VEHICLES FLED. ONE VEHICLE STOPPED IN A NEARBY APARTMENT COMPLEX AFTER HITTING A CURB. TWO SUSPECTS FLED ON FOOT. OFFICERS LATER FOUND AND DETAINED BOTH SUSPECTS. OFFICERS DISCOVERED THAT THE VEHICLE HAD JUST BEEN STOLEN FROM A NEARBY RESIDENCE WHERE YET ANOTHER PERSON HAD SHOT AT THE STOLEN VEHICLE.
