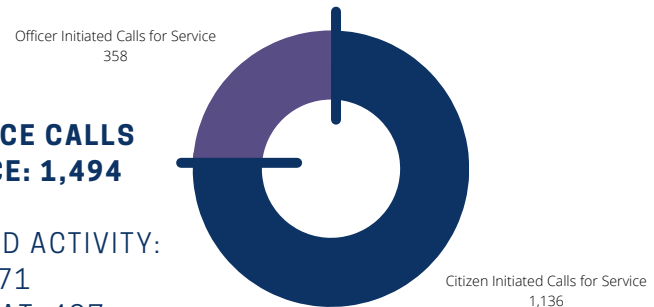

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- POLICE RESPONDED TO A COLLISION IN THE 3900 BLOCK OF FLOOD AVENUE. A PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION SHOWS A TWO-DOOR MITSUBISHI TRAVELING NORTHBOUND CROSSED THE CENTER INTO ONCOMING TRAFFIC. THE CAR STRUCK A SOUTHBOUND PICKUP HEAD-ON. THIS CAUSED THE MITSUBISHI TO SPIN AND COLLIDE WITH A SECOND SOUTHBOUND VEHICLE. ONE PERSON DIED AT THE SCENE. ANOTHER PERSON WAS TREATED AND RELEASED FROM A LOCAL HOSPITAL.
