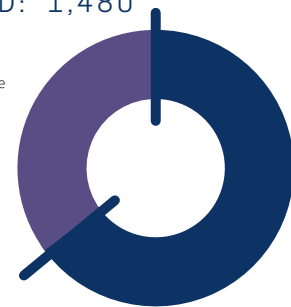

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A TRESPASSING CALL AT A HOTEL. THE PAGE UNIT SUSPECTED THE SUBJECTS IN THE HOTEL WERE JUVENILE RUNAWAYS THAT ARE SUSPECTS IN NUMEROUS BURGLARIES AND AUTO THEFTS. OFFICERS ARRIVED ON SCENE AND THREE JUVENILES RAN FROM THE AREA. ALL THREE WERE APPREHENDED BY PATROL OFFICERS AFTER A SHORT FOOT PURSUIT. THE THREE JUVENILES WERE ALL WANTED OUT OF CLEVELAND COUNTY AND OKLAHOMA COUNTY. TWO FIREARMS WERE RECOVERED (ONE BEING STOLEN OUT OF OKLAHOMA CITY) AS WELL AS CDS. THE JUVENILES HAD OTHER STOLEN PROPERTY ON THEM LINKING THEM TO A PHARMACEUTICAL BURGLARY IN NORMAN. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING
- COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED A REPORT OF A HOUSE FIRE ON FAY AVE. RESPONDERS FOUND ONE PERSON, POSSIBLY WITH MOBILITY ISSUES, DECEASED INSIDE THE HOME. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
