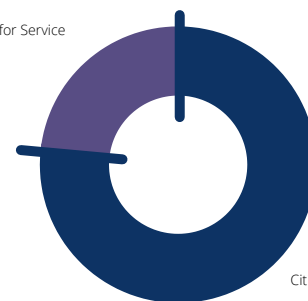

WEEK IN REVIEW

- NPd RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION IN THE AREA OF 24TH AVE NE AND FRANKLIN RD ON FEB. 9 AT 8:52AM. A TRUCK TRAVELING WESTBOUND ON FRANKLIN APPROACHING 24TH AVE NE HIT ANOTHER VEHICLE TRAVELING NORTHBOUND ON 24TH AVE WHO FAILED TO STOP AT THE STOP SIGN. THE DRIVER OF ONE OF THE VEHICLES WAS TRANSPORTED AN AREA HOSPITAL WHERE THEY LATER DIED FROM INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE COLLISION. THE CRASH REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CIRT TEAM.
- NPd RESPONDED TO AN ARMED HOSTAGE SITUATION IN THE 200 BLOCK OF WOODCREST DRIVE ON FEB. 12 AT 10:58 PM. THE MALE SUSPECT WAS ASSAULTING A FEMALE VICTIM AND HAD KNIVES AS WELL AS GUNS IN THE RESIDENCE. HE WAS ALSO MAKING THREATS TO KILL THE FEMALE VICTIM. THE NPd SWAT TEAM, LED BY NEGOTIATORS, UTILIZED DE-ESCALATION TECHNIQUES TO ALLOW THE HOSTAGE TO GET FREE AND ULTIMATELY TOOK THE SUSPECT INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT.
- OFFICERS TOOK PART IN TIP-A-COP AND THE POLAR PLUNGE IN SUPPORT OF SPECIAL OLYMPICS OKLAHOMA RAISING NEARLY \$8,000.
