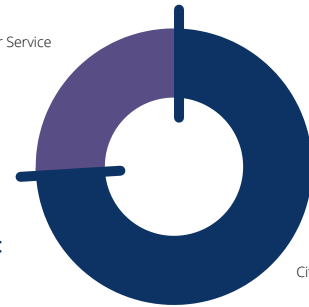

- OFFICERS UTILIZED INFORMATION FROM A RECENT AUTO BURGLARY INVESTIGATION TO IDENTIFY A SUSPECT AND RECOVER A LARGE AMOUNT OF CONFIRMED AND SUSPECTED STOLEN PROPERTY RELATED TO MULTIPLE CASES AROUND THE OKC METRO AREA. TO DATE, 10-12 VICTIMS HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AND THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- OFFICERS PARTICIPATED IN THE 2022 LAW ENFORCEMENT TORCH RUN AND THE SPECIAL OLYMPICS SUMMER GAMES OPENING CEREMONY.
