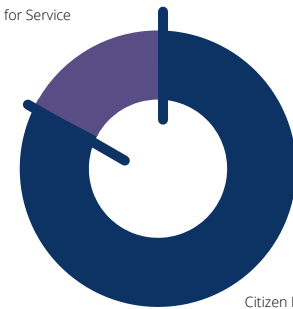

WEEK IN REVIEW

- POLICE WERE NOTIFIED OF A SHOOTING IN THE 800 BLOCK OF LEXINGTON STREET. WHEN OFFICERS ARRIVED, THEY FOUND A DECEASED 21-YEAR-OLD MAN IN A VEHICLE. INVESTIGATORS IDENTIFIED A SUSPECT WHO WAS INTERVIEWED AND LATER ARRESTED ON A FIRST-DEGREE MURDER CHARGE.
- OFFICERS ASSISTED ODOT IN CONTACTING PEOPLE IN THE I-35 RIGHT OF WAY REGARDING RECENT NOTICE TO VACATE THE AREA SO THAT REPAIRS COULD BE MADE TO THE DAMAGED STRUCTURE. RESIDENTS WERE PROVIDED NECESSARY INFORMATION AND ENSURED ACCESS TO RESOURCES AVAILABLE FOR THEIR TRANSITION. DUE TO EXCEPTIONAL COMMUNICATION SKILLS, EMPATHY, AND A VARIETY OF ONGOING EFFORTS, NO ENFORCEMENT ACTION WAS REQUIRED OR TAKEN.
- P.A.C.E. CONTACTED THE MOTHER OF A MISSING PERSON. THE TEAM FOUND A PERSON MATCHING THE DESCRIPTION ON A CITY BUS. OFFICERS MADE CONTACT WITH THE PERSON AND PROVIDE RESOURCES FOR UNIFICATION WITH THEIR FAMILY.
