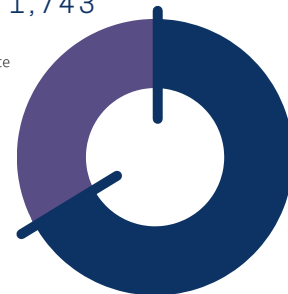

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS CONTACTED A VICTIM OF A ROAD RAGE. THE VICTIM MAY HAVE CUT-OFF THE SUSPECT. THE SUSPECT THEN STARTED FOLLOWING THEM. THE VICTIM HEARD 5 SHOTS BEING FIRED. THERE WERE NO INJURIES OR DAMAGE.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A DOMESTIC ABUSE COMPLAINT AND CRASH IN A WALMART PARKING LOT WHERE THE SUSPECT FLED THE SCENE ON FOOT. OFFICERS LOCATED THE SUSPECT AT THEIR RESIDENCE AFTER THE VICTIM HAD GONE TO A NEIGHBOR'S HOUSE. THE SUSPECT REFUSED TO COME OUT OF THE HOUSE. NEGOTIATORS RESPONDED BUT WERE UNSUCCESSFUL. OFFICERS LATER CONTACTED THE SUSPECT ON HWY 9 AND ARRESTED HIM FOR MULTIPLE OFFENSES AND OUTSTANDING WARRANTS.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO CAMPUS CORNER WHERE AN INTOXICATED VICTIM WAS ASSAULTED AND THEIR PHONE/CAR KEYS WERE TAKEN BY AN UNKNOWN SUSPECT. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED AND RECEIVED TREATMENT FOR NON-LIFE THREATENING INJURIES.
- NPD WAS DEEPLY INVOLVED IN THE RESPONSE TO THE TORNADO IN SE NORMAN. THE DEPARTMENT COORDINATED THE CITY INCIDENT COMMAND AND STABILIZATION EFFORTS.
- NPD'S UPDATED VALUES INCLUDE - COLLABORATION: WE WILL WORK IN PARTNERSHIP WITH STAKEHOLDERS, OTHER AGENCIES, AND WITHIN OUR DEPARTMENT TO STRENGTHEN OUR CITY.
