

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A STABBING IN THE 2100 BLK OF W MAIN ON 2/18, ONCE ON SCENE, THEY CONTACTED A SUBJECT WITH A SINGLE STAB WOUND. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THE SUBJECT HAD BEEN INJURED AFTER FORCING THEIR WAY INTO AN APARTMENT AND ASSAULTING THE RESIDENT BECAUSE OF A FLAG BEING FLOWN OUTSIDE. DURING THE COURSE OF THE ALTERCATION, THE SUBJECT WAS STABBED. THE SUBJECT WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT. CRIMINAL CHARGES BURGLARY AND ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON ARE PENDING.
- PATROL RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF DOMESTIC ABUSE AND KIDNAPPING THE 500 BLK OF 24TH AVE NW ON 2/18, THE VICTIM WAS REPORTEDLY ASSAULTED AND THEN HELD AGAINST THEIR WILL ALL DAY. THE VICTIM EVENTUALLY ESCAPED BY ATTACKING HER CAPTOR WITH A PAIR OF SCISSORS. THE SUSPECT WAS PLACED INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- OFFICERS WERE CALLED TO THE 2300 BLOCK OF 24TH AVE SW ON 2/21 IN RESPONSE TO INDIVIDUALS WHO WERE CRIMINALLY TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY. DURING THE OFFICERS' RESPONSE AND INVESTIGATION, TWO OFFICERS WERE AGGRESSIVELY APPROACHED BY TWO UNLEASHED DOGS. THE OFFICERS ATTEMPTED TO UTILIZE LESS LETHAL TOOLS, BUT DUE TO THE VICIOUS NATURE OF THE ANIMALS' APPROACH AND CONCERN FOR THEIR SAFETY, BOTH OFFICERS DISCHARGED THEIR FIREARM AT THE ANIMALS. BOTH ANIMALS DIED AS A RESULT OF THE SHOOTING.
- · OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A DISTURBANCE INVOLVING A WEAPON IN THE 600 BLK OF WELSTON CIRCLE ON 2/22. THE REPORTING PARTY SAID A TRUCK HAD RUN OVER A MAILBOX RESULTING IN A DISTURBANCE BETWEEN TWO SUBJECTS IN FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE. ONE OF THE SUBJECTS WENT INTO THE RESIDENCE, AND THE DRIVER OF THE TRUCK FOLLOWED THEM AND FORCED THEIR WAY INSIDE. WITNESSES HEARD WHAT SOUNDED LIKE TWO GUNSHOTS BEFORE THE DRIVER OF THE TRUCK CAME BACK OUTSIDE, GOT IN THE TRUCK, AND DROVE TO THE BACK OF THE RESIDENCE. OFFICERS ATTEMPTED TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE OCCUPANTS OF THE RESIDENCE, BUT THERE WAS NO RESPONSE. OFFICERS THEN MADE ENTRY AND EVENTUALLY LOCATED TWO HIGHLY INTOXICATED OCCUPANTS WHO ADMITTED TO BEING INVOLVED IN THE ALTERCATION. THE DRIVER OF THE TRUCK WAS CITED FOR THE COLLISION WITH THE MAILBOX.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 32 ANIMALS ADOPTED. 3 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER. AND 2 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED OUT TO RESCUES THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 62 ANIMALS AND HAVE 121 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 13 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS
