

WEEK IN REVIEW

- · NPD KICKED OFF ITS 21ST CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY WITH 23 PARTICIPANTS. THIS 11-WEEK COURSE PROVIDES AN IN-DEPTH AND HANDS-ON LOOK INTO HOW OUR POLICE OFFICERS PERFORM THEIR DUTIES AND HOW THE AGENCY SERVES THE COMMUNITY.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SUSPICIOUS ITEM NEAR A PLAYGROUND IN THE 800 BLOCK OF N. PETERS AVE ON 3/5. WITNESSES REPORTED SEEING TWO SUBJECTS PLACE AN UNKNOWN OBJECT INTO A TREE STUMP AND THEN ATTEMPT TO CAMOUFLAGE IT BEFORE LEAVING THE AREA, ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED THE ITEM. DUE TO ITS SUSPICIOUS NATURE, THE HAZARDOUS DEVICES UNIT RESPONDED AND RENDERED THE ITEM SAFE. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED.
- NPD RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A POSSIBLE EXPLOSIVE DEVICE IN THE 200 BLOCK OF N. PONCA AVENUE ON 3/7. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS AND THE HAZARDOUS DEVICES UNIT RENDERED THE POSSIBLE DEVICE SAFE. AN ALL-CLEAR WAS ISSUED. INVESTIGATORS HAVE IDENTIFIED AND CONTACTED THE INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DEVICE. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- · OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN ASSAULT IN THE 2400 BLOCK OF HUNTING HORCE TRAIL ON 3/7. THE VICTIM WAS CURRENTLY IN THE EMERGENCY ROOM REPORTING THAT SHE HAD BEEN STABBED BY A FAMILY MEMBER DURING A VERBAL ARGUMENT. OFFICERS LOCATED THE SUSPECT AT THE RESIDENCE. THE SUSPECT WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT. THE VICTIM REMAINED HOSPITALIZED AT AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE INCIDENT. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- · ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 27 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 6 RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS, AND 1 TRANSFERRED TO A RESCUE THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 46 ANIMALS, THERE ARE 116 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 17 OF THOSE CURRENTLY HOUSED WITH FOSTERS
