The City of Norman suspended the debris removal operation related to the May 10, 2010 storms on Thursday, June 10, 2010 to allow property owners more time to place their debris on the street right of way. Debris removal will resume on Monday, June 21, 2010. Citizens are encouraged to have their debris ready for pick up as soon as possible. The final pass in all areas will be made by the week of July 5<sup>th</sup>. At least one and up to 2 passes will be made in all areas. The City of Norman would like to dispose of all debris as soon as possible. Citizens are reminded to:

- Separate vegetative debris from construction and demolition debris;
- Cut all debris in lengths of less than 22 feet so it will fit into the contractor's trucks;
- Not place debris in the right of way so that it causes a sight obstruction to vehicular traffic, particularly near street or driveway intersections;
- Not place debris near fire hydrants, mail boxes, water meters or anything that can be damaged by the contractor's equipment;
- Remove parked vehicles or other obstructions from the public street when the debris removal contractor is working.
