On Sunday October 16, 2011, the contractor will paint the concrete aesthetic features on the Rock Creek Bridge over I-35. The contractor will begin work on the bridge pier located between the I-35 north and southbound lanes from 7:30 a.m. to approximately 9:30 a.m. During this time, I-35 will be reduced to four lanes of traffic since the north and southbound inside lanes will be closed to traffic. After the center pier is finished, the contractor will move to the west pier and close North Interstate Drive underneath the Rock Creek Road Overpass from 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Barricades will be placed on North Interstate Drive between Rock Creek Road and Bart Connor Drive. The temporary detour will be 36th Avenue NW between Rock Creek Road and Tecumseh Street. Throughout this temporary closure of North Interstate Drive, access to residences and businesses in the vicinity of Rock Creek Road will be provided for local traffic and emergency services. Signs will be placed accordingly to direct the traveling public.

The Rock Creek Road Overpass Project From 24th Avenue NW to 36th Avenue NW is a \$12 million street improvement project. Construction began on Monday, June 7, 2010. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation is responsible for the construction of the project and the prime contractor is Silver Star Construction of Moore, Oklahoma.
