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The City Traffic Control Division will be upgrading the traffic signal at the Main Street intersection with Interstate Drive/26th Drive on Wednesday, January 11, 2011, weather permitting, in order to improve traffic flow. After 9:00 a.m., the intersection will be temporarily controlled by an all-way STOP sign. Signal operation should be restored before 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday (same day). During this time, City Traffic Control Division crews will be making improvements for left-turning traffic from the two side street approaches.

The changes will be to upgrade some of the existing signal equipment and to change the left-turn phasing on the two side street approaches to feature flashing yellow arrows. These changes will improve the traffic flow on both of the side street approaches to this intersection.
