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On Monday October 1st, 2012, the contractor will shift traffic from the west side of 24th Avenue NW to the east side. One lane of 24th Avenue NW will remain open to traffic in each direction. This shift will allow the contractor to construct the intersection improvements on the west side of the road. Weather permitting; the construction on the west side of 24th Avenue NW should be completed by early November 2012. After completing construction on the west side, construction activity will cease until the beginning of next year, when the contractor will install the traffic signals.

The 24th Avenue NW and Legacy Park Drive Intersection Project is a \$700,000 street improvement project. This project involves the construction of intersection improvements including traffic signals, turning lanes, stamped and colored concrete pavement, sidewalks and ramps and decorative street light poles. This intersection will be similar to several other intersections in the University North Park such as 24th Avenue NW at Conference Drive and 24th Avenue NW and Rock Creek Road. The prime contractor is CGC, LLC of Edmond, Oklahoma.
