SIGNAL UPGRADES AT 24TH AVENUE NW AND BOARDWALK STREET/PARKLAND WAY

City Traffic Control Division personnel will be upgrading the traffic signal installation on 24th Avenue NW at the Boardwalk Street/Parkland Way intersection. The work to be accomplished includes the replacement of one signal head, replacement of the signal monitor, modification to existing traffic signal wiring, and the addition of a traffic control sign. The change will add a protected-permissive flashing yellow arrow signal head for northbound to westbound 24th Avenue NW traffic (wishing to turn onto Boardwalk Street). This work will take place on Wednesday, June 18, 2014, weather permitting. After 9:00 a.m. on June 11th, the intersection may be temporarily controlled by an all-way STOP sign. Full signal operation should be restored at the intersection by 12:00 p.m. on the same day.
