PUBLIC MEETINGS TO DISCUSS NEW LIBRARIES FOR NORMAN

The City of Norman and the Pioneer Library System (PLS) will host another series of public meetings with representatives from the architectural firm hired to update the City of Norman's plans for new public libraries. Representatives from Meyer, Scherer & Rockcastle (MSR) will be in Norman on October 5th and 6th. MSR representatives previously received input on residents' opinions and ideas on their library needs and what they would like to see incorporated into future library designs during meetings on September 7th and 8th. Library services for Norman are provided through a partnership between the City of Norman and the PLS. The City of Norman provides and maintains the facilities while PLS operates the libraries, providing staff, materials and technologies. PLS provides library services for all of Cleveland, McClain and Pottawatomie counties.

Sites for future libraries in east and central Norman have been identified. The proposed central Norman location is on the northwest corner of the intersection of James Garner Avenue and Acres Street, on land formerly used by the Rhodes Grain Company. The proposed site for the east Norman branch library is at 3001 E. Alameda Street, adjacent to Norman Fire Station No. 9.
