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### **NEW TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT 36<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE SE** **AND STATE HIGHWAY 9**

Traffic Signals, Inc., the traffic signal subcontractor on the State Highway 9 widening project, will be removing temporary signal equipment at the State Highway 9 intersections with 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE, Technology Place, and John Saxon Boulevard and activating the new traffic signal at the 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE intersection with State Highway 9 on Tuesday, March 24, 2015, weather permitting. After 9:00 A.M., work will begin on State Highway 9 at 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE and proceed east toward 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE. During some periods of time, all movements through the intersection of State Highway 9 and 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE may be controlled by all-way STOP control as the contractor's crew works in the intersection turning vehicular traffic signal heads to line up appropriately with the approaches to be controlled. The new traffic signal is intended to serve significant future developments on either side of State Highway 9. The installation is part of the ongoing project to widen State Highway 9 in this area.
