(2) Approval of July 2014 Meeting Minutes

(3) Agenda

- A. Bike Share Overview for Walmart in Norman (Angelo, Council Member Greg Heiple)

Walmart (Cedar Lane area; SE corner of Classen/Cedar Lane; 1200+ new residential area too) – zoned Industrial to Commercial; trying to get new development to be more bicycle friendly; attempting to get bikeshare ('use your walmart credit card'); attempting to get more access and racks for bicycles/tri-cycles; covered bicycle parking → still "potential" hoping it will become the first bicycle-friendly Walmart.

- B. Adding new Bike Lanes on Identified Collector Streets (Gary)

OCARTS Regional Master Plan

p.27 matrix

- volumes and speed – and level of stress and need for facility
- Some streets like Jenkins need treatment to increase safety/flow
- Some streets are collectors don't need treatment (treatment = infrastructure of any kind)

- C. Adding "Bicycle May Use Full Lane" Signage (All)

Four lane – Not part of "Bicycle May Use Full Lane", bicycle lane is likely better solution
Two lane – criteria in Norman; Sharrows, Bike Make Use Full Lane

Sharrow alone may not be tied to a particular sign

- Using draft grouping notes of potential roads – reordered as shown below:

Group A. Rationale: These are the roads most used by students and where i think signs will more quickly impact driver behavior.

2. E Constitution, Classen Blvd to Jenkins
5. Boyd St, End of marked bicycle lane between Moreland & Oklahoma to Classen
4. S Jenkins, Duffy St to Constitution
8. University, Acres to Boyd
9. Webster/Asp, Daws to Boyd
3. 24th Ave East, E Robinson to E Lindsey, E. Tecumseh to E. Rock Creek Rd
13. Cedar Ln east current construction project to 84th (group A)

Group B. Rationale: These are roads frequently used by Norman cyclists.

6. Berry, Imhoff to Robinson
7. Lindsey St, Jenkins to 24th Ave SW
10. Imhoff, Chautauqua across Highway 9 to S McGee Dr
11. E Tecumseh, 12th Ave NE to 24th Ave NE
12. 48th NW from Robinson to Indian Hills

- 12 Ave SE from Cedar Lane to Hwy 9 (currently under construction; 500' of 12th Cedar Lane North; 2nd project will connect – hold off on signage until construction is completed within about a year or so)

Action: Angelo will look at ADTs for all of the above roads for determining implementing the signage program for “Bicycle May Use Full Lane”.
