C. Bike to Work Day Planning – May 15, 2015


BLN will post event to Facebook

D. Potential skills course at Ruby Grant Park / Sutton Woods additional area / Saxon

- Sutton Woods “annex”: 65 acres owned by City of Norman; potential for a 2-3 miles for a skills course; accessible from Legacy trail or Carter Ave extends into road between soccer fields and medical area / Findlay has a better intersection (traffic light)
 - James Briggs discussed the idea of looking at the various options using aerials/Google Earth
 - T. Woodfin indicated that Tobin at BLN has examples of skills courses, user agreements, layouts, etc. → may want to bring his expertise to present the concepts to decision-makers.
 - Establish parameters for a skills course details
 - Looking at the location options in Norman
 - Need to begin discussing these concepts with key people/PowerPoint
 - Next BAC Kim and Gary will look at the options and present at next meeting

E. Bike/Ped Counts reporting

We didn't have volunteers for this week; David Riesland did the same video counts for the same locations as last count. We will re-gear up to get volunteers for fall data counts again.

First week of April would be better for Norman next year.

F. Engagement with Norman Forward effort

- Weekly meetings have been held for planning of projects for Norman Forward

- Presentation from Canadian River Conservancy last week – looking at land donation for a large wilderness park; trails, access from Lindsey (floodplain area near small park near 36th)
- Surveys and meetings will be in May for the projects

 - Cedar Ln. -> delay due to rain, actual product for the color for the bike lane has been tricky (pigment on epoxy, pigment on the glass bead options); should be open early summer
