April 5, 2011

The City Council of the City of Norman, Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma, attended a Sister City Reception and Signing Ceremony at 5:00 p.m. at the Norman Municipal Building on the 5th day of April, 2011, and notice of the reception was posted at the Municipal Building at 201 West Gray 48 hours prior to the event. The reception was open to members of the Passport Sister City Committee and was open to anyone with an interest.
