City Council, in its meeting of October 28, 2008, approved Contract No. K-0809-75 with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for construction of the Rock Creek Road Bridge over I-35 with the City of Norman's share of the project being \$1,576,000. The Ribbon Cutting Ceremony of the Rock Creek Road Bridge over I-35 was followed by a reception at Embassy Suites Hotel located at 2501 Conference Drive. The Rock Creek Road Project was a collaboration between the City of Norman, Oklahoma, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.
