The 24th Avenue NW and Legacy Park Drive Intersection Project is a \$700,000 street improvement project. This project involves the construction of intersection improvements including traffic signals, turning lanes, stamped and colored concrete pavement, sidewalks and ramps and decorative street light poles. This intersection will be similar to several other intersections in the University North Park such as 24th Avenue NW at Conference Drive and 24th Avenue NW and Rock Creek Road. The prime contractor is CGC, LLC of Edmond, Oklahoma.

On Wednesday, August 22, 2012, the northbound lanes of 24th Avenue NW from Mount Williams Drive to Conference Drive will be closed in order to construct the east side of the intersection. The northbound traffic will be diverted to the west side of the road. Weather permitting, the construction on the east side of 24th Avenue NW should be completed by early October 2012. After completing construction on the east side, construction activity will shift to the west side of the road and the detour will be moved to the east side of 24th Avenue NW. The roadway portion of this construction project should be completed by early November 2012. The traffic signal portion of the project will be completed in January 2013.
