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CEDAR LANE ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Beginning Wednesday, June 18, 2014, Duit/TTK Construction will begin to install construction signage along Cedar Lane Road between 12th Avenue SE and 36th Avenue SE in preparation of the Cedar Lane Road Project. Signs will be placed to alert drivers to the upcoming roadway construction. The contractor will begin construction on Monday, June 23, 2014. During this phase, two lanes will remain open to traffic. The initial phase of construction will include:

- Temporary widening of the roadway along Cedar Lane Road, 12th Avenue SE and 24th Avenue SE to accommodate lane shifts
- Installation of storm water pipe needed to drain the existing ditches during construction

The Cedar Lane Road Widening Project is an \$8.1 million street improvement project. When the project is complete, the roadway will be widened to four lanes with 5-foot bike lanes adjacent to the curb, the intersection of 12th Avenue SE and Cedar Lane Road will be widened and signalized, dual left turn lanes from 12th Avenue SE onto eastbound Cedar Lane Road, the railroad at grade crossing will become a quiet zone crossing, and a 5-foot sidewalk will extend the length of the project on both sides of Cedar Lane Road. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation will be administering the construction of the project on behalf of the City of Norman. The prime contractor is Duit/TTK Construction from Edmond, Oklahoma. The project has an estimated completion date of June 2015.
