### **Wylie Road at Lindsey Street Intersection Closed**

Beginning Friday, June 5, 2015, at 9 a.m. Cimarron Construction, the City's utility contractor for the Lindsey Street Project will close Wylie Road at the Lindsey Street intersection to install the Common Utility Trench across Wylie Road. Weather permitting, the closure should be reopened Sunday morning, June 7. Signs will be placed to direct the traveling public.

On August 28, 2012 the citizens of Norman voted in favor of a bond issue to finance the local share of eight projects. Lindsey Street from 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue Southwest to Berry Road is a project included in the package. The proposed improvements are:

- Widening Lindsey Street from three lanes to four lanes with a raised median
- New bridge over Imhoff Creek
- Continuous sidewalks on both sides of the street
- Multi-modal improvements including bicycle lanes
- Aesthetic enhancements including decorative pavement, landscaping, and roadway lighting
- Underground utilities
- Accessibility to disabled individuals
- Improved drainage system on Lindsey Street
