80,000 square-feet | approximately \$39 M | opening Spring 2019 (estimated)

Design for proposed Central Branch Library located at the intersection of Acres Street and James Garner Blvd.

Site designed for minimal maintenance, managed stormwater run-off, with convenient parking, easy drop-off, and a covered walkway from parking. Exterior plaza for public gatherings and events faces Andrews Park. The east building entrance connects the library to Legacy Trail.

Highly flexible space will support a mobile service approach, new education models, collaborative learning, and information sharing. The Library will support digital literacy with a Digital Classroom, Maker Space, and tablet lending services throughout the building.

Children's area with 102 reader seats, 4 reading alcoves and a 2,000 square-foot Storytime Room.

Teen area with 24 reader seats and 6 computer stations.

Adult collection with 200 reader seats, 45 computer stations, and 6 study rooms.

Numerous public meeting spaces: large Multipurpose Room with seating for 300, smaller Multipurpose Room with seating for 56, 2 conference rooms and outdoor balcony on upper level.








