WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS ARREST ONE FOR BURGLARY IN THE 2500 BLOCK OF BROOKS ON APRIL 12. THE REPORTING PARTY TOLD OFFICERS THAT HE GOT INTO HIS VEHICLE TO FIND AN UNKNOWN SUBJECT IN THE BACKSEAT. THE SUBJECT RAN AWAY WITH SEVERAL ITEMS FROM THE VEHICLE.
 OFFICERS LOCATED AND ARRESTED THE SUBJECT NEARBY.
- THE PROACTIVE POLICING UNIT (PACE) IDENTIFIED AND ARRESTED TWO INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED IN THE ROBBERY AND ASSAULT OF AN ELDERLY MALE ON REGENT STREET ON APRIL 11. THE ARREST OCCURRED WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE INCIDENT. STOLEN PROPERTY WAS ALSO RECOVERED DURING THE ARREST.
- NPD ARRESTED A 14-YEAR-OLD JUVENILE IN REFERENCE TO A
 ROBBERY IN THE 900 BLOCK OF GOSHAWK DRIVE ON APRIL 15. THE
 JUVENILE STRUCK A 78-YEAR-OLD MALE IN THE FACE WITH BRASS
 KNUCKLES AND TOOK HIS WALLET. OFFICERS ARRESTED THE JUVENILE
 A COUPLE OF BLOCKS AWAY FOLLOWING A SHORT FOOT PURSUIT. THE
 JUVENILE WAS BOOKED INTO AJC FOR ROBBERY. THE VICTIM WAS
 TREATED AND RELEASED FOR NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES.
- THE SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS SECTION ARRESTED ONE FOR AGGRAVATED POSSESSION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY AFTER INVESTIGATORS DISCOVERED THE SUBJECT WAS ACTIVELY TRADING ILLICIT IMAGES WITH ANOTHER SUBJECT OUT OF STATE. THE ONGOING INVESTIGATION IS BEING DONE IN PARTNERSHIP WITH HOMELAND SECURITY.
- THE SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS SECTION ARRESTED ONE IN
 CONNECTION TO THE ILLEGAL TRANSPORT OF APPROXIMATELY 200
 POUNDS OF MARIJUANA TO AN OUT OF STATE LOCATION.
