- PATROL RESPONDED TO A SUBJECT ARMED WITH A SWORD WHO HAD MADE THREATS TO HARM OTHERS AND OFFICERS. THE SUBJECT WAS EVENTUALLY PLACED INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT.
- ON THE EVENING OF JULY 4TH, OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A VEHICLE
 ACCIDENT IN EAST NORMAN. OFFICERS DETERMINED A PICKUP TRUCK
