## WEEK IN REVIEW

- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 33 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 6 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. IN ADDITION, A TOTAL OF 65 ANIMALS WERE TAKEN INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 228 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 77 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
- THE PACE UNIT WORKED IN CONJUNCTION WITH CIS DETECTIVES TO APPREHEND 3 INDIVIDUALS WHO HAD ACTIVE WARRANTS FOR CHILD ABUSE. THROUGHOUT THE WEEK, PACE OFFICERS CONDUCTED MULTIPLE PROJECTS TO LOCATE THE INDIVIDUALS, WHO WERE ALL ARRESTED AND BOOKED INTO THE CLEVELAND CO. DETENTION CENTER WITHOUT INCIDENT.
- OFFICERS WERE RESPONDING TO DISTURBANCE WITH WEAPONS CALL ON SEPT. 8 WHEN A MOTORIST UNEXPECTEDLY TURNED IN FRONT OF THE OFFICER'S VEHICLE CAUSING A COLLISION. THE TWO OFFICERS AND OTHER MOTORIST WERE TRANSPORTED BY EMSSTAT FOR NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES. BOTH THE POLICE VEHICLE AND THE CITIZEN'S VEHICLE SUSTAINED SIGNIFICANT DAMAGE AS A RESULT OF THE COLLISION.
