DUE TO DESCRIPTIONS AND INFORMATION PROVIDED BY WITNESSES, OFFICERS QUICKLY LOCATED THE SUSPECT A SHORT DISTANCE AWAY. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED ON A COMPLAINT OF ASSAULT WITH A DANGEROUS WEAPON. THE INVESTIGATION REVEALED THE SUSPECT ENTERED THE RESTAURANT AND STRUCK AN EMPLOYEE IN THE BACK WITH A SHARP OBJECT BEFORE LEAVING. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING IN THE 2000 BLOCK OF ALAMEDA ST ON 11/10. THE REPORTING PARTY TOLD COMMUNICATION OFFICERS THAT THE SUSPECT HAD FIRED A HANDGUN AT HIS EX-GIRLFRIEND AND THEN POINTED IT AT HER AS SHE STOOD WITH HER TWO CHILDREN.
