As a result of these changes, all bidders are required to submit more detailed information regarding the manufacturer, type and number of light poles and fixtures that will be a part of the bid proposal.

Also, the successful/chosen bidder *only* shall be required to produce engineered Construction Drawings for this project for review and approval, as described in the changes listed above. Costs for these drawings shall be a part of all bidders' proposals; however *only* the chosen bidder shall be required to produce them.

#### **Request For Proposal**

YFAC Pickleball Courts 2201 Trae Young Drive Norman, OK 73069 RFP 2324-43

The City of Norman Parks and Recreation Department will be accepting proposals for the construction of a lighted, outdoor six (6) post-tensioned concrete pickleball court facility, including all associated court surfacing, striping, lighting, fencing and nets at the Young Family Athletic Center, addressed above. Proposals will be accepted until 5:00 p.m., Friday, March 22, 2024. The primary project cost includes all **engineered Construction Drawings**, permits, plan review, site preparation, labor, and all materials, testing, and inspection costs associated with this type of construction. All work shall receive inspection and approval consistent with similar construction in Norman and should, thus, be accounted for in all proposals.

- It is the intention of the City of Norman to provide a complete six (6) court outdoor
  pickleball facility as specified below. The City of Norman and the project architect,
  JHBR Architecture, will provide conceptual layout design documents (attached).
  The contractor shall provide all other necessary materials, incidentals, methods, and
  labor necessary to furnish a complete project ready for use. All materials shall be
  new and free from defects.
- 2. All initial proposals shall be accompanied by an itemized schedule of included features for the build package as provided by the City. All associated costs for building permits and construction inspections (including soil compaction/proctor tests, slump, fracture, post-tensioning, and other associated concrete testing) incurred by the chosen contractor shall be included in the budget/cost proposal prepared in response to this RFP. The City of Norman will pay all costs associated with site clearing and utility re-location (if any) associated with this project and either do that work in-house or via a separate contractor. Water is available at no cost to the chosen contractor at the site to aid in the curing process.
- 3. Codes and Standards: All design and construction shall be in compliance with all relevant sections of the ANSI Codes (latest version) as well as the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG) and Uniform Federal Accessibility Standards for such facilities. The project shall, further, be designed and constructed to follow all pertinent guidelines set forth in the International Building Codes [(IBC): 2018 version] as adopted by the City of Norman as it pertains to all design factors as needed to gain approval by City of Norman construction plan review. Court construction shall follow the most current specifications (attached) set forth by the USA Pickleball Association (USAPA).
- 4. Facilities that provide maximum use while incorporating safety and low maintenance will be preferred.

- 5. Proposals shall include a project list where similar facilities have been constructed. If available, submit locations within the OKC metropolitan area and a contact person for each job.
- 6. All proposals will be evaluated based on the company's experience with this type of project, the availability of construction materials, and the time required to complete the requested work.
- 7. Operations will consist of field checking design, dimensions, points of connection, construction of the entire facility, and any appurtenances. Parks and Recreation Staff will be available for on-site meetings prior to the RFP Submission deadline to discuss any concerns over the site and project, including a pre-proposal conference at the project site (see item 19 below). Please call (405) 366-5480 for questions about this project.
- 8. The chosen contractor will obtain any necessary City, State, or Federal permits at their sole cost. The contractor shall be responsible for all underground utility locations at the job site using both the CALL OKIE location service AND through meeting with Parks and Recreation staff to locate each party's specific electrical and irrigation lines, in particular. Any existing underground utilities that become damaged during the project (including utility supply or service lines (including any valve boxes, manholes, and all in-ground service access covers), valves, meters, or any other utilities) shall be repaired by the contractor or have the repair paid for by the contractor at no cost to the City of Norman. All utilities used at the current facility shall be made available for the new court construction project (Parks and Recreation Project Manager will assist in scheduling all utility connections).
- 9. Scope of Work: The Contractor shall provide all items necessary to construct the improvements described completely. Appurtenance and/or accessories and material testing not herein mentioned but necessary to furnish a complete facility ready for use upon delivery shall be included. The contractor shall make a field inspection of the project site and determine the extent, cost, and methods necessary to construct the project properly. Only the chosen Contractor shall be responsible for producing engineered construction drawings of the 6-court facility they intend to build in the space for review and approval prior to commencement of the work. However, all bidders shall include all costs associated with production of these drawings as part of the total bid price of the turn-key proposal submitted in response to this RFP. The installation must be coordinated with the City of Norman to minimize the impact on other users and other construction projects at the site. All facility operational, care, and maintenance instructions shall be demonstrated and thoroughly described to the Parks and Recreation Department by the successful contractor at no extra cost to the City prior to final acceptance by the City of Norman.
- 10. Site Access and Care: The contractor shall be given such access to the site as necessary to complete the project. Personal vehicles and work trucks must park in the existing parking lot. Construction vehicles will be able to access the drive that wraps around the backside of the athletic center. This is a one-way that flows north to south. A lay-down yard and/or job trailer (if needed) location will be made available in the existing parking lots on or in the lots located adjacent to the project site via permission granted in written form from the Norman Parks and Recreation Department, once work commences. The contractor shall protect existing features to stay during construction and will be responsible for repairing or replacing any damage caused by construction with equivalent materials within a time frame deemed acceptable by the City of Norman Project Manager. The contractor shall repair or replace any damage at their sole expense.
- 11. All standard manufacturer's or dealer warranties for all materials and fixtures used for this project shall be supplied in writing, covering the replacement of all defective parts and workmanship assurances associated with those materials. All materials

shall be new, unused, and free of defects and imperfections and delivered to the job site in their original container with seals/packing in place and unbroken. All concrete shall conform to the specifications outlined in the USAPA specifications for this type of court construction; all testing results shall be submitted to the City of Norman Project Manager and approved before final acceptance of the project.

- 12. The contractor with the successful proposal will be required to enter a Construction Contract with the City of Norman and shall be required to provide a Performance Bond, Statutory Bond, and Maintenance Bond, as well as proof of professional liability insurance and worker's compensation insurance in limits prescribed by Oklahoma law. All affidavits and forms included in this packet shall also be supplied at the time of submission of Proposals. All bidders shall submit their proposals by filling out the Bid Proposal Form included in this packet. No other bid forms shall be accepted as compliant with the specifications for this project.
- 13. The primary objective of this project is to construct the six (6) court pickleball facility, including all necessary fences, nets, lighting, surfacing, and line work, according to design documents provided by the City of Norman. The items on the bid form are for the construction of these items.
- 14. The project range shall consist of the following:
- a) The overall size of the post-tensioned concrete slab will be 109' 9.5" by 129' 0" with a color-coated finish (color TBD), white line work, with all nets and associated post and anchor structures/hardware necessary to produce six (6) USAPA Pickleball Courts on the new slab.
- b) A ten (10) foot tall perimeter chain link fence (nine (9) gauge wire with a black PVC finish around the nine (9) gauge wire) with black posts, hardware, and tension wire around the new courts. Fence posts (line and corner) shall be Schedule 40 material and placed outside of the post-tensioned slab <a href="Footing design for perimeter fence posts shall be submitted for review and approval prior to construction as part of the engineered Construction Drawings produced by the chosen contractor only.">Footing design for perimeter fence posts shall be submitted for review and approval prior to construction as part of the engineered Construction Drawings produced by the chosen contractor only.</a> Two (2) 4' 0" walk gates shall be included on the west side of the facility (as shown on provided design documents).
- c) Interior four (4) foot tall chain link fence (nine (9) gauge wire with a black PVC finish around the nine (9) gauge wire) with black posts, hardware, and tension wire between all courts (as shown on provided design documents). All fence posts and rails shall be Schedule 40 material and post placement shall be a part of the engineered Construction Drawings produced by the chosen contractor only. NOTE: This interior fence shall be a permanent feature and NOT removable/in sleeves as shown on the conceptual drawings included in this packet.
- d) Light posts with LED down-lighting (as shown on provided design documents). Light type, number of fixtures and manufacturer shall be described in the bidders proposal and any relevant product information shall be submitted with the bid for approval by the City of Norman prior to award of construction contract. Final Construction Drawings shall include a light level plot for all 6 courts that must be reviewed and approved by Project Manager prior to installation.
- e) Our intention is to construct all items on the bid form. Price breakdown information will only be used if the budget does not allow for all of the construction items to be awarded at this time.
- f) Provide engineering assistance during construction, including securing all required posttensioning and concrete testing by a third party.

- g) Once approved for construction, the engineered Construction Drawings provided by the chosen contractor for this project shall be followed by the construction contractor unless modified via a signed change order issued by the City of Norman. All materials, labor, incidentals, means, and methods necessary to construct the six-court facility (as approved and itemized on the attached bid form, which is made part of any construction contract) shall be included in the pricing on the attached bid form.
- h) Provide as-built construction drawings for the project, upon completion—showing all new construction and connection(s) to features existing prior to construction, as well as all drainage patterns on the new construction and all known utility locations.
- Sidewalk connections to the new courts are to be completed by others, via a separate contract.
- 15. All items shall be priced as part of the base bid as the most common commercial-grade product for this type of construction that is able to meet the specifications outlined in the attached information from the USAPA. The goal of this RFP is to get the maximum value for the available budget while meeting all applicable standards for construction and inspection. Final design details will be negotiated with the successful bidder <u>during the production of the engineered Construction Drawings that will be required of the successful bidder.</u> Base proposals are most concerned with including those items and design orientation described herein. As stated, all material, labor, equipment, and appurtenance necessary to provide the structure, ready for use, as described, which are not mentioned in this RFP but are essential to the project, are understood to be included in the bidder's base bid costs.
- 16. The base bid shall be to construct an outdoor six (6) court Pickleball facility complete with all the necessary finishes, surfacing, furnishings, lighting, nets, fences, striping, and structures as outlined above and described in bidder's proposal.
  - Add-alternate items on the Bid Form, if any, may be considered prior to entering into a construction contract so the final contract price is clearly in accordance with the Bid Form included in this RFP. Once the project is awarded, all final accepted items shall be reflected in the final plans for the new facility.
- 17. Any add-alternate options can be discussed further at the pre-bid meeting or any other time through coordination with the project manager.
- 18. Work is to be completed within 120 calendar days from the issuance of a Notice to Proceed to the site and weather conditions that meet those appropriate for construction. The project site is an active athletic center. Work times and days may have to be scheduled to accommodate regular and/or special events. Final terms of start/stop dates will be addressed in the final contract between the successful bidder and the City of Norman.
- 19. Interested bidders are invited to attend a pre-bid meeting with representatives from the City of Norman Parks and Recreation Department at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 6, 2024, at the Young Family Athletic Center, 2201 Trae Young Dr., Norman, OK 73069 (see location map). Other meeting times can be arranged by contacting the project manager listed below.

The City of Norman reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.







