**2019 City Council Candidate**  
**Filing Requirements For Mayor and Wards 1, 3, 5 and 7**

***Candidates must file at:***

Cleveland County Election Board, 641 East Robinson, Suite 200

***Qualifications:***

Candidates must be a qualified voter in the city of Norman for six months prior to the date of the municipal election and Ward City Councilmembers must also live in the Ward at the time of filing.

***Filing Date:*** December 17, 18, 19, 2018

***Election Dates:*** February 12, 2019 (Municipal) & April 2, 2019 (Runoff)

In the event no candidate receives a majority of all the votes cast as the municipal election a municipal run-off will be held between the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes for Mayor and in each Ward.

***Procedures:***

- (1) Submit a written declaration of candidacy setting forth the candidate's name as he or she desires it to appear upon the ballot, address by street number, and the name of the office to become a candidate; and
- (2) **Cashier's check or certified check in the amount of \$50.00; or** in the alternative by a petition supporting the candidate's filing signed by **50 registered voters** eligible to vote for the candidate for the position of City Councilmember and **in the amount of \$75.00; or** in the alternative by a petition supporting the candidate's filing signed by **75 registered voters** eligible to vote for the candidate for the Mayoral seat. The check shall be returned to the candidate immediately if the candidate is unopposed in the Municipal Election, receives more than fifteen percent (15%) of the total votes cast in the Municipal Election, or becomes a candidate in the Municipal Run-off Election.

**Voter Registration**

The deadline is January 18, 2019, to register to vote or change your registration for the February 12, 2019, municipal Mayoral and City Council Wards 1, 3, 5, and 7 elections.

Visit [ok.gov/elections](http://ok.gov/elections) to download a [voter registration application](#) or get more information on [registering to vote](#). You can also get voter registration applications at the [state election board office](#), your [county election board office](#) or [post offices](#), [tag agencies](#) and [libraries](#).

If the winner of the Feb. 12th election earns a majority of the votes, that candidate will be sworn in to a two-year term as on July 2nd. If no candidate receives a majority, the two candidates with the most votes will stand in a decisive run-off election April 2nd.

The Norman Council is nonpartisan and members serve part-time at the head of the City's Council-Manager form of government.

## **Voting Information**

All Norman voters registered by the Jan. 18th deadline are eligible to vote in the municipal election Feb. 12th.

Use your voter ID card or the Oklahoma State Election Board's [online voter tool](#) at [ok.gov/elections](http://ok.gov/elections) to find your polling location or confirm your registration.

[State law](#) requires proof of identity to vote. Acceptable forms of ID are a voter ID card, driver's license or another form of ID issued by the federal government, state government or federally recognized tribal government.

The deadline to submit request for an absentee ballot for the municipal election is 5:00 p.m. Feb. 6th. [Apply for an absentee ballot](#) or [download an absentee ballot request form](#) at [ok.gov/elections](http://ok.gov/elections).
