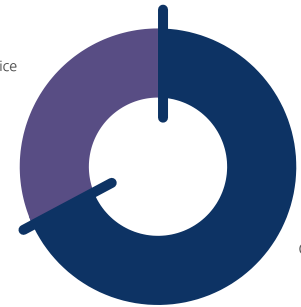

WEEK IN REVIEW

- NORMAN POLICE ARREST ONE IN THE AREA OF BEAUMONT DRIVE AND GRILL AVE. BASED ON THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION, ONE SUSPECT WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST FOR MULTIPLE CHARGES TO INCLUDE BURGLARY IN THE FIRST DEGREE AND BURGLARY IN THE THIRD DEGREE.
- NPD RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A ROBBERY IN THE 300 BLOCK OF ST. CLAIR DR. ON MAY 18 AT 11:04AM. THE VICTIMS WERE WORKING IN THE AREA WHEN THE SUSPECTS APPROACHED WITH A HANDGUN AND DEMANDED THEIR WALLETS. THE SUSPECTS ALSO TOOK EQUIPMENT FROM THEIR TRUCK. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- NPD UTILIZED NUMEROUS RESOURCES INCLUDING THE DEPARTMENT'S DRONE TEAM TO LOCATE A MISSING JUVENILE IN A HEAVILY WOODED AREA ON MAY 18.
- NPD RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A ROBBERY IN THE AREA OF E. JOHNSON ST. AND N. CRAWFORD AVE. ON MAY 20 AT 9:42AM. THE VICTIM WAS WORKING IN THE AREA WHEN THE SUSPECT APPROACHED HIM WITH A KNIFE AND DEMANDED HIS WALLET AND PHONE. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
