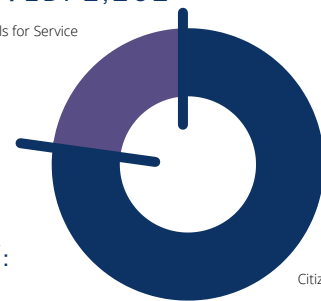

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- BACK TO SCHOOL SAFETY REMINDERS: WHEN LIGHTS ARE FLASHING IN A SCHOOL ZONE, STOP AND YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS, NEVER PASS A SCHOOL BUS STOPPED FOR PEDESTRIANS, TAKE EXTRA TIME TO LOOK FOR CHILDREN NEAR SCHOOLS AND PLAYGROUNDS, AND ALWAYS STOP FOR CROSSING GUARDS HOLDING UP A STOP SIGN.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A DISTURBANCE INVOLVING A SUBJECT WHO THREATENED TO KILL HIS MOTHER AND RESPONDING OFFICERS. THE MOTHER ESCAPED AND CALLED POLICE. WHEN OFFICERS ARRIVED, THEY FOUND THE SUBJECT BARRICADED IN THE RESIDENCE. THE SWAT TEAM RESPONDED AND NEGOTIATED THE SUBJECT'S PEACEFUL SURRENDER. AN UNINVOLVED NEIGHBOR, HOWEVER, BEGAN INTERFERING WITH OFFICERS AND HAD TO BE ARRESTED SO THAT THE INCIDENT COULD BE RESOLVED SAFELY.
- PATROL RESPONDED TO SUBJECTS ATTEMPTING TO BREAK INTO VEHICLES ON HAZELWOOD DR. OFFICERS LOCATED AND DETAINED THE SUBJECTS, REVIEWED VIDEO EVIDENCE, AND FOUND STOLEN PROPERTY IN THEIR POSSESSION.
