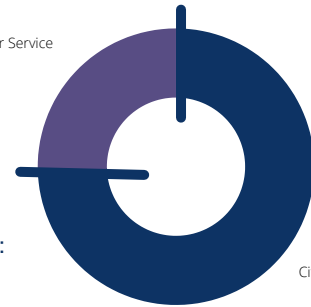

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- POLICE WERE CONTACTED ABOUT A PERSON LAYING IN A DITCH NEAR CLASSEN BOULEVARD AND BOYD STREET. WHEN OFFICERS ARRIVED, THEY FOUND A DECEASED MALE. DETECTIVES WERE NOTIFIED AND RESPONDED. THE DEATH REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BUT FOUL PLAY IS NOT SUSPECTED.
- OFFICERS RECEIVED A STOLEN VEHICLE REPORT. POLICE FOUND THE VEHICLE ABOUT 15 MINUTES LATER. THE SUSPECTS WERE FOUND IN A LOCAL MOTEL ROOM. DURING THE INVESTIGATION, OFFICERS FOUND STOLEN PROPERTY, DRUG PARAPHERNALIA AND FENTANYL. POLICE ARRESTED TWO SUSPECTS WHO CONFESSED TO STEALING THE VEHICLE AND POSSESSING THE DRUGS.
