WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A FIGHT WITH WEAPONS IN THE 1400 BLOCK OF ALAMEDA ST ON 5/20. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT TWO INDIVIDUALS WERE ARGUING WHEN ONE PERSON PULLED A KNIFE AND CUT THE OTHER ON THE BACK OF THE LEG. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL WITH NON-LIFE THREATENING INJURIES. THE SUSPECT WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND THE KNIFE WAS RECOVERED.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A COLLISION WITH INJURY IN THE 15700 BLK OF E. HWY 9 ON 5/20. PRELIMINARY INFORMATION SHOWS THAT A CAR ATTEMPTED TO TURN WESTBOUND ONTO HWY 9 IN FRONT OF A TRUCK TRAVELING EASTBOUND ON THE ROADWAY. THE TRUCK STRUCK THE CAR IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROADWAY. BOTH THE DRIVER AND PASSENGER OF THE CAR WERE TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL WITH SEVERE INJURIES. THE DRIVER OF THE TRUCK WAS NOT INJURED. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CIRT.
- AN OFFICER OBSERVED A SUBJECT CHECKING VEHICLE DOOR HANDLES IN THE 1800 BLOCK OF W. ROBINSON ON 5/22 AND ATTEMPTED TO CONTACT THE INDIVIDUAL. THE OFFICER ISSUED VERBAL COMMANDS, BUT THE SUSPECT TURNED AND SHOT IN THE DIRECTION OF THE OFFICER, THE OFFICER RETURNED FIRE AND THE SUSPECT RAN FROM THE SCENE, NO ONE WAS INJURED. LATER, OFFICERS TOOK TWO 17-YEAR-OLD MALES INTO CUSTODY AS A RESULT OF THE INVESTIGATION. THE SAME INDIVIDUALS WERE ALSO INVOLVED IN AN EARLIER DRIVE-BY SHOOTING IN THE 100 BLOCK OF W. DALE WHERE AN OCCUPIED RESIDENCE WAS STRUCK MULTIPLE TIMES. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION.
- · NORMAN INVESTIGATORS ARREST ONE INDIVIDUAL ON MULTIPLE COUNTS OF LEWD ACTS WITH A CHILD AND POSSESSION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY ON 5/25. THE ARREST FOLLOWED A MILLTI-MONTH INVESTIGATION FOLLOWING A REPORT IN 2022 THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAD MOLESTED A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 12 WHILE THEY WERE IN HIS CARE.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE PARTICIPATED IN AN OFFSITE ADOPTION EVENT AT THE NORMAN TWILIGHT MARKET. SEVEN DOGS WERE ADOPTED DURING THE EVENT.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE TOOK IN 88 ANIMALS DURING THIS WEEK, BRINGING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ANIMALS IN OUR CARE TO 213. WE ARE CURRENTLY OPERATING AT CRITICAL CAPACITY. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, ALL ADOPTION FEES ARE WAIVED
