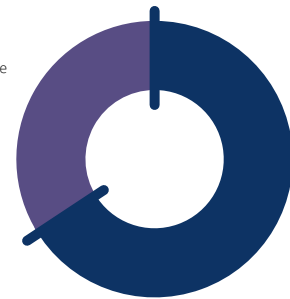

WEEK IN REVIEW

- PATROL RESPONDED TO A COLLISION AT HWY 9 NEAR JOHN SAXON BLVD. PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION INDICATES A VEHICLE WAS EASTBOUND ON HWY 9 AND A PEDESTRIAN CROSSED WHERE THERE WAS NO CROSSWALK. THE PEDESTRIAN WAS STRUCK BY THE VEHICLE AND WAS SUBSEQUENTLY TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL WHERE THEY DIED AS A RESULT OF INJURIES SUSTAINED IN THE COLLISION. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- NORMAN COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED A CALL REGARDING A COLLISION NEAR PORTER AVE AND MOSIER ST. INITIAL INFORMATION INDICATES A SUBJECT RIDING A TRAIL BIKE WAS TRAVELING NORTH ON PORTER WHEN IT WAS STRUCK BY A VEHICLE TURNING INTO THE HOSPITAL. THE RIDER OF THE TRAIL BIKE WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL THEY WERE PRONOUNCED DECEASED.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE IS PARTICIPATING IN "CLEAR THE SHELTER" THIS MONTH AND IS OFFERING HALF-PRICE ADOPTIONS.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 39 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 5 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS, AND THEY TOOK IN 50 ANIMALS. THERE ARE CURRENTLY 212 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE - 63 OF THOSE ANIMALS ARE IN FOSTER PLACEMENT.
- SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS HAVE COMPLETED ALL REQUIRED TRAINING TO PREPARE THEM FOR ANOTHER SCHOOL YEAR. THEY ARE BACK IN THEIR ASSIGNED SCHOOLS AND INTEGRATING WITH THE SCHOOL STAFF.
- P.A.C.E. OFFICERS INITIATED AN UNDER 21 OPERATION AFTER INFORMATION WAS RECEIVED ABOUT UNDERAGE INDIVIDUALS PURCHASING ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS AT LOCAL CONVENIENCE STORES. APPROXIMATELY 14 STORES WERE SHOPPED, AND 3 SEPARATE LOCATIONS WERE CITED.
