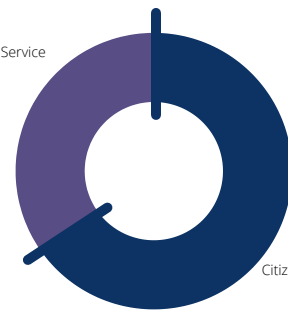

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A ROBBERY IN THE AREA OF 12TH AVE AND ALAMEDA ON 11/21. BASED ON THE DESCRIPTION AND INFORMATION ON DIRECTION OF TRAVEL PROVIDED BY THE REPORTING PARTY, OFFICERS LOCATED THE SUBJECT A SHORT DISTANCE AWAY. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THE SUBJECT STRUCK THE VICTIM IN THE CHEST WITH A CLOSED FIST BEFORE TAKING THE VICTIM'S CASH FROM HIS POCKET. OFFICERS ARRESTED THE SUBJECT WITHOUT INCIDENT AND TRANSPORTED HIM TO CCJC.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A ROBBERY IN AN APARTMENT COMPLEX IN THE 1100 BLK OF BILOXI DR. ON 11/23. THE VICTIM WAS IN THE LAUNDRY ROOM WHEN TWO SUBJECTS ATTACKED THEM BY THROWING THEM DOWN AND HITTING THEM SEVERAL TIMES IN THE HEAD. THE SUBJECTS TOOK THE VICTIM'S WALLET AND CELL PHONE, AND THEN FLED THE AREA. THE VICTIM WAS PROVIDED MEDICAL CARE AT THE SCENE. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- PATROL WAS CALLED TO THE AREA OF SHILOH AND CARRA JO DR. FOR A POSSIBLE SHOOTING ON 11/26. NO VICTIMS WERE LOCATED OR IDENTIFIED AT THE SCENE. A WITNESS REPORTED OBSERVING TWO SUBJECTS WALKING IN THE AREA WHEN A THIRD INDIVIDUAL CAME UP FROM BEHIND THEM AND FIRED WHAT APPEARED TO BE TWO GUNSHOTS IN THEIR DIRECTION. THE TWO SUBJECTS THEN RAN FROM THE AREA. THERE WERE NO OTHER WITNESSES OR ANY FURTHER INFORMATION PROVIDED.
