Dear Madam and Sir:

Referendum Petition 2425-1 was filed in my office on Friday, September 20, 2024, signed by Pamela Sue McCoy-Post, Paul Thomas Arcaroli, and Richard Lorene Sandag regarding Ordinance O-2425-2, the adoption of the Rock Creek Entertainment Project Plan.

The number of signatures required for a referendum petition is twenty-five percent of the number of votes cast in the preceding general municipal election. That election was April 5, 2022, and the number of voters was 24,393 necessitating 6,098 signatures be obtained. Petition signatures were filed in my office on October 17, 2024, and I began my verification process on Tuesday, October 22, 2024. A total of 10,689 signatures were verified and the petition appears to be sufficient. Legal notice will be published in the Norman Transcript on Sunday, November 10, 2024. A protest to the petition may be filed by any qualified elector of the City in District Court within 10 days after the publication in the newspaper. This is the stage when the number of signatures, eligibility of those signing, the ballot title, and the appropriateness of the subject matter may be contested. If such protest is filed, the District Court is to set a day for hearing the protest within 10 days after the filing of the protest. After the hearing, the District Court shall decide whether such petition is in form required by law.

If the petition is ultimately deemed to be sufficient, the question shall be submitted to the registered voters of the municipality for their approval or rejection at the next general election on February 11, 2025.
